NUGENT

On Sunday 27th March we will be having a second collection to support Nugent, our official Archdiocesan caring service. This year marks the 200th anniversary of the founder, Fr. James Nugent. Inspired by his work to educate children in Liverpool, support women prisoners in Walton prison and care for the poor, his legacy continues with Nugent today. Nugent offers services for children, families, communities, those with disabilities and older people and providing a welcome to Syrian families under our community sponsorship scheme. We are also now supporting local Muslim communities who asked to join the scheme following a generous response from the parishes.
