#### RESTORING THE SUNDAY OBLIGATION

Message from the Bishops Council of England & Wales May 2022. The situation of the last two years has meant that the Sunday Obligation has been impeded We thank God that this situation has now changed. Most people have resumed the wide range of normal activities, no longer restricted by the previous Covid measures. We therefore believe that the reasons which have prevented Catholics from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation no longer apply. Looking forward to the forthcoming feast of Pentecost, Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June, we now invite all Catholics who have not yet done so to return to attending Mass in person.

"Virtual viewing" of Mass online does not fulfil the Sunday Obligation. It may, however, be a source of continual spiritual comfort to those who cannot attend Mass in person, - those who are elderly and sick.

<u>COUNCILLOR MARIE MORGAN</u>, who has represented Winstanley on Wigan and Leigh Council for many years, has been elected to the office of Mayor for 2022/23.

St. Aidan's has been asked to host the Civic Sunday Service at 11.00am on Sunday 26th.June.
