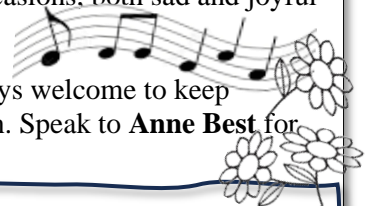

CAFOD: Fix the Food System Campaign: Weekend 29th/30th July

there will be an appeal at St Jude's for people to sign a petition to the World Bank to support Selina a small farmer of Bangladesh for the right to control her own seeds. The petition will stay at the back of church until the following weekend.

"God blessed them and said, 'See, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is upon the earth and every tree with seed as its fruit; you shall have them for food.'" (Gen. 1: 29). CAFOD's Parish Campaign is to ensure that small farmers who grow nearly half of the world's food can continue to choose to use their own seeds and not be made dependent on huge seed corporations funded by the World Bank. You can support the campaign by signing jointly a letter from **Salina** to the World Bank to address this matter at their October meeting.
