(Gen. 1: 29).* CAFOD's Parish Campaign is to ensure that small farmers who grow nearly half of the world's food can continue to choose to use their own seeds and not be made dependent on huge seed corporations funded by the World Bank. You can support the campaign by signing jointly a letter from **Salina** to the World Bank to address this matter at their October meeting. 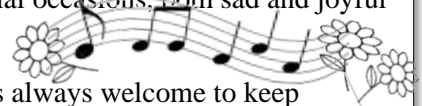
Mass offerings were made, and candles lit, for the intentions of all the parishioners of St Jude's & St Aidan's.
