**FIX THE FOOD SYSTEM:** CAFOD'S food campaign is urging the Government to protect the right of farmers round the world to use their own seeds.

Seeds are life. They are the foundation for farmers to produce food that feeds us all. For generations small scale farmers have freely swapped and shared a wide variety of seeds to produce food and maintain biodiversity. More recently farmers have also developed seeds that ensure crops are resilient to climate change. However, their right to choose what seeds they use is increasingly under threat as new laws are introduced across the world that limit what small farmers can do with their seeds.

Peter Mather will explain at St Aidan's how you can help to support farmers' choices.
