St MAXIMILIAN KOLBE *Feast Day 14th August*

St John Paul II often referred to Maximilian Kolbe as the 'patron of our difficult century', no doubt because he saw in Kolbe's sacrifice – his life selflessly given for another's in Auschwitz-Birkenau Nazi death camp, as the very relevant message that even in the most extreme and negative of circumstances, the God-created human person is still capable of holding to their dignity, and making free choices for the greater good of humanity.

"The most deadly poison of our time is indifference," Kolbe once said, and warned that "hate is not creative. Only love is creative."
