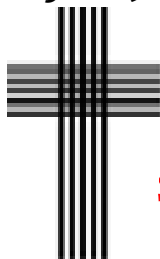

The Stained-Glass Series in St Jude's Church

How many of us know the symbolism contained in the 12 spectacular windows in St Jude's? Look carefully at the glass and find the images in the colours and shapes.

WINDOW THREE

This window depicts the early Christian symbol of the fish. If viewed three fish can be seen within one, thus symbolising the Blessed Trinity.
